ORIGINAL CONCEPT

The Faculty Association Grant Program was conceived by the teachers of the RCM to support individuals within the community in pursuit of their musical studies, to allocate and provide financial aid, as well as to foster a progressive and creative environment within the school.

WHO CAN APPLY

New and returning RCM students, as well as individual RCM Faculty members will be able to apply for support from the Faculty Association Grant Program.

CREATIVE STUDIES AND INITIATIVES

Financial support will be made available for a wide range of academic studies and/or specific creative projects and initiatives. Successful applicants will be provided financial support for their desired course that can range from SmartStart, Private Instruction (any instrument), to History, Harmony, Choir or Conducting—i.e. any curriculum currently on offer from The RCM—to further develop their creativity and overall musicianship.

CRITERIA FOR SUBMISSIONS

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee based on their specific merit and originality of attitude towards the individual's approach to their musical studies. The committee's aim is to foster creative initiative within the RCM community, as well as to encourage and support innovative approaches to musical study for the individual Teacher or Student.

WINNERS

Winners may be invited to perform in an award-winners concert and write a thank-you statement for the Faculty Association Newsletter.

This grant is not designed to cover the full cost of a course. It is intended to partially support the pursuit of music education within the Royal Conservatory Community.
